

Junior Camp

Created to provide young children ages 3, 4, and 5 with a positive introduction to Day Camp and the out-of-doors.

Children that have completed Kindergarten and seem to be comfortable with group situations are better equipped to handle Transitional Day Camp.

A Sample of Daily Junior wrangler Camp Schedule

8:30	Campers arrive - Supervised Play in Play Yard
9:30	Snack
9:45	ponies
10:45	Movement skills with Director
11:45	ponies
12:00	Lunch (Campers bring their own from home)
12:30	Quiet Time (Story Time, Videos, Play Room)
1:30	Arts and Crafts and change for swimming
2:15	Swimming
3:15	Snacks and more afternoon swimming
4:00	Departure

Junior Campers have their own program and Director, separate from regular day camp. Daily swimming, including lessons, All other activities vary daily including pony riding, story time, video rest period, arts and crafts, trampoline, classroom play, separate age-appropriate play yard, animal care(feeding ponies, bunnies, fish) climbing structures, tricycle (big wheel) riding, nature exploration, movement(yoga and gymnastics), organized games, creative dramatics and modified sports.

- A three (3) year old entering this program does best with a minimum of 6 months pre-school experience.
- **All Junior Campers MUST BE TOILET TRAINED.**
- Junior Camp groups limited to 10 campers (co-ed) with a counselor and a Junior Counselor, a 3:1 ratio or better.
- Junior Campers must bring their lunch, as hot lunch is not available. All receive morning and afternoon snacks.
