As our camp population grows, we are excited to meet the interests of all campers with newly improved programming. Our qualified staff will do their best to introduce your children to Western, English, and Bareback riding styles, and equine rescue care. Each week campers will participate in daily horseback lessons, crafts, and camp games. In the afternoon sessions campers will take part in trail rides, swimming pool, water games and equine care such as learning to bathe. The dedicated staff at Pleasant Valley Horse Club is looking forward to having another great season.

Please make sure you fill out all your forms and return them before camp begins. Last year's forms are not acceptable to admit your child to camp.

Your child must be signed in each morning by a parent/guardian and must be signed out each afternoon with pickup. The sign in and out sheet will be located just outside the office building.

What to send your child with to camp:

- Closed toed shoes (we have barrow boots available)
- Lunch
- Snack
- Change of clothes as we have daily water activities
- Bathing suit (we go swimming Tuesday Afternoon)
- Towel
- Please apply sun block in the morning and we will re-apply sunblock to your child when necessary.
- Send a labeled container of sun block. We find the spray type is the best.
- Your child will also need to bring a labeled water bottle to camp every day. We will be happy to fill the bottle all day for them. Water bottles are necessary at camp.

For those campers enrolled in afternoon camp we will be swimming Tuesday afternoon. Each camping will need to take part in the "swim test," In order to swim in the deep end of the pool and jump off the diving board. Our swim test consists of campers swimming from the shallow end of the pool to the deep end then back to shallow end without touching the sides of the pool. Those who choose not to do the swim test or those who do not pass will need to stay in the shallow end with adult supervision.

We will be creating a virtual horse show for friends and family to watch. The link to the show will be sent out in 1 weeks time after the final camp date. The video is only able to be seen by those that have the link. If for any reason you don't want your child's photograph on display, you must inform us in writing. Otherwise, we assume that it is okay to take photos. No names will ever be used.

We hope your child's summer experience is safe and rewarding for you and your family. If there is anything you need to discuss with us feel free to call anytime.
